UC's clerical staff provides the administrative backbone of the University. Thus, we have to be taken seriously.

A short strike by UC clerical staff will be successful if everyone who possibly can participate joins us on the picket line. The more of us who exert pressure on the University, who make this personal statement of support, the more "persuasive" we will be at the bargaining table. And the more effective our message will be that UC must deal with us in good faith.

UC will try to convince clerical staff that it is illegal to strike, although that's simply not true. UC will threaten to discipline employees if they participate in the strike, but CUE will stand behind any employee subjected to such illegal actions by management and will fight for every employee's legal rights to be respected. UC will say whatever it can to diminish the number of people standing together, and that is because they want to split us apart and claim that our demands for good faith bargaining and fair pay and working conditions are not demands that all clericals support.

A hardship fund has been set up to assist CUE members who stay off the job and who do picket duty at least 4 hours/day. Whether the local Executive Board calls a one-, two- or three-day strike, it is of the utmost importance that you and your coworkers stay off the job, and show up on the picket line to demonstrate your support.
