

**FOLLOW THE BELOW INSTRUCTIONS for the CUE affiliation vote**

1. Mark your Vote
2. Put your ballot in the enclosed ballot envelope
3. Print your name (legibly to ensure your vote is counted), sign, and seal the ballot envelope
4. Return your ballot envelope to the proper CUE polling location

This election is being conducted in accordance with the CUE Constitution

Article XV AFFILIATION OR DISSOLUTION

- A. CUE is not affiliated with any other union. Any decision to affiliate with another union must be approved by members in accord with these provisions: A motion to affiliate or to dissolve CUE may be called by a vote of a majority of the executive board or by a petition supported by 20% of the members statewide. Once such a vote has been successfully called for, the executive board shall refer the matter to vote to be called within 60 days. The executive board shall send notification to all members and it shall include the referendum and the arguments representing different points of view.

The results of a vote shall be considered valid if 50% of the members have voted, and will be determined by a vote of two-thirds of votes cast.

- B. This non-affiliation status does not prevent statewide CUE or any local from working with other unions or other organizations in coalitions or joint projects.
- C. If CUE is dissolved, any unexpended funds and properties shall be donated to a non-profit organization selected by the members.
